ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75 PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THORNLEIGH GREEN, SWORDS, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from Fingal County Council's Active Travel Department for permission to temporarily close Thornleigh Green, Swords, Co. Dublin for the purpose of facilitating a temporary creation of a "School Street" as part of European Mobility week. It is proposed that the roads will be closed from 16th September until 22nd September 2025 from 08:00 to 08:30 and 12:00 to 14:15.

No works shall take place on weekends and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling along Thornleigh Green heading North:

Traffic will turn right at Applewood Main Street then take a left onto Thornleigh Road, take a left onto Thornleigh Green and a right onto Thornleigh Square.

Traffic travelling along Thornleigh Green heading South:

Traffic will turn left onto Thornleigh Green, take a right onto Thornleigh Road then a right onto Applewood Main Street and finally a left onto Thornleigh Green.

Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
