Beneficiaries of Temporary Protection (BOTP)

- The Ukraine Response Team is currently processing a large volume of Online Temporary Protection Renewal (OTPR) applications from Beneficiaries of Temporary Protection (BoTPs). This means that it may take some time for an applicant's application for renewal to be processed. If an applicant's application for Temporary Protection is successful, they will then be sent their new Irish Residency Permit (IRP) card and Temporary Protection certificate. *Source: [Notice for Employers of Beneficiaries of Temporary Protection - Immigration Service Delivery](#).*
