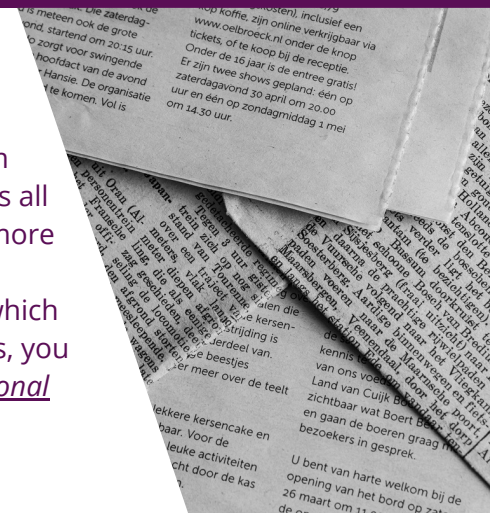

International Protection Applicant (IPA)

- From July 2025, the IPO will be accelerating the processing of applications from Pakistan. Accelerated applicants undergo the same decision-making process as all other international protection applicants, but have their cases dealt with in a more timely manner.
