



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75
PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
COILL DUBH COURT, MALAHIDE, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been made by GMC Utilities on behalf of Irish Water to temporarily close part of Coill Dubh Court, Malahide, Co. Dublin.

The purpose of this closure is to facilitate drinking water connection works.

The period of the proposed temporary closure will be from 9.00am Monday 24th of November 2025 to 5.00pm on Friday 28th of November 2025.

The alternative routes for traffic travelling in the area during the proposed closure are as follows:

Direction of Travel	Alternative Routes
East to Coill Dubh Court	Use Coill Dubh Avenue, Grove or View

No left turn from the Malahide Road into the residential area of Coill Dubh Court, except for local access residents (including pedestrians and cyclists) along the length of the closure.
