



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURES OF ROSCALL AND GRACEDIEU ROAD, CO. DUBLIN.

An application has been received from Suir Engineering for permission to temporarily close Roscall and Gracedieu Road, Co. Dublin for the purpose of facilitating a horizontal directional drill under R129. It is proposed that the roads will be **closed from 29th of October 2025 to 28th of November 2025 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **07:00hrs and 20:00hrs** Monday to Friday and between **08:00hrs and 16:00hrs** on Saturdays.

No works shall take place on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling to Roscall Road from North:

Travel east on Baldrumman Road, turn right onto R132 southbound, continue for 8.2km on R132 southbound, take 3rd exit on Estuary Roundabout onto R125 eastbound, turn right onto Balheary Rd northbound, turn left on Balheary Road after Broadmeadow River westbound, continue onto Balheary Avenue westbound, turn right onto Balheary Road northbound, continue onto Harlockstown Lane northbound. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Traffic travelling to Roscall Road from South:

Travel south on Harlockstown Lane, continue onto Balheary Road southbound, turn left onto Balheary Avenue southbound, continue on Balheary Road eastbound, turn right on Balheary Road southbound towards Swords, turn left onto R125 eastbound, take 3rd exit on Estuary Roundabout on R132 northbound, continue for 8.2km on R132 northbound, turn left onto Baldrumman Road westbound, then left onto Roscall Local southbound.

Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
