

Who is Eligible?

- Not-for Profit organisations operating in Fingal
- Tidy Towns, Community Groups, Residents Organisations
- Youth Clubs, Active Age, Mens/ Women's Sheds
- Sports Clubs, GAA, Soccer, Sailing, Scouts, Tennis, Cricket, Cycling
- Can have Charitable Status, Articles of Association, Regular minuted meetings/ AGM
- Applicants should be members of the Fingal Public Participation Network (PPN) or The Wheel
- This grant covers projects that will reduce emissions
 - *This grant is not for 'learning' and does not cover workshops and festivals/ awareness events
- Please note *Schools and Educational facilities are not eligible,
 - *businesses/ commercial entities are not eligible, but projects can include working with businesses to reduce waste/ water/ energy



Projects are 100% funded, 3 scales of grants available in this competitive application process

Small Scale Projects - Up to €20K

Medium Scale Projects - €21K to €50K

Large Scale Projects - €51K to €100K

Each Application should cover up to 5 Themes



Themes - Project Ideas to Reduce Emissions

- **1. Community Energy:** Solar Panels, Building Insulation, Heat Pump on a Community Building, LED Lighting in car park/ community area/ sports pitch
- **2. Community Travel:** Cycle Parking infrastructure in Community area, Group cycling, bike lockers, bikeshare schemes, bike repair stations, electric bike charging
- **3.** Community Food & Waste: Community Composting, Leaf Mould Collections, Community Food Bank/ sharing, Working with local businesses to reduce Food Waste, Packaging, Community Gardens
- **4.** Community Local Climate & Environmental Action: Sand Dune/river/watercourse/ Habitat Restoration, Planting Trees, Planting Biodiversity Area, Community Gardens
- **Community Shopping & Recycling:** Working with local businesses to reduce waste, introduce local return/ Repair/ swap schemes, reduce packaging

Project Ideas

- Building Fabric Upgrades
 - Roof/attic & wall Insulation
 - Replacement of Windows and doors
- Renewable Energy Solutions
 - Solar PV Panels
 - Heat Pumps
- Energy Efficient Lighting
 - LED lighting : interior & exterior floodlighting
 - Car Parks



Project Ideas

- Heat Recovery Solutions
- Smart Metering
 - What gets measured gets managed
- Technological improvements
 - Building Management Systems
 - Thermostatic controls
 - Heating Controls
 - Ventilation Controls

Next Steps

- Assess Your Buildings
 - You may be entitled to a FREE Energy Audit, if your annual energy spend is over €10k, from SEAI (€2k Voucher Support System)
 - Baseline Energy Consumption
 - Schedule of Improvements
 - Cost vs Impact Assessment
- Obtain 3 Quotes for recommended works as per your energy audit

- There will be one lead group in the application
- Each application might have multiple groups involved
- Fingal County Council will assess the applications and partner with the groups in the Application to the Department for the grant
- Meetings should be minuted and all agreements recorded
- Following approval, the lead group will receive 25% upfront funding, if necessary. Group bank details will be submitted as part of the application
- More payments can be drawn down as the project is verified/ vouched
- All parties must have a Bank/ Credit Union Account & treasurer

Applications

- Contact the Community Climate Action Officer (CCAO)
- Applications are online through the Submit Portal
- Arrange a meeting to discuss application proposals
- All items must be submitted into the portal in advance of the deadline
- Deadline for Applications is Monday 22nd December 5pm
- These are long-term projects
- Complete an Energy Audit if you are applying for a technology upgrade such as solar panels/ heat pump
- Obtain 3 quotes for the projects not required to go with the cheapest quote but you must get 3 quotes
- Gather whatever paperwork is required (6yr lease/ renting agreements from property owner)
- Applications scored as according to Department Guidelines
