



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALHEARY ROAD, SWORDS, CO. DUBLIN.

An application has been received from Suir Engineering for permission to temporarily close **Balheary Road, Swords, Co. Dublin** for the purpose of cable installation. It is proposed that the roads will be **closed from 24th of November 2025 to 10th of December 2025 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **07:00hrs and 19:00hrs** Monday to Friday and between **08:00hrs and 16:00hrs** on Saturdays.

No works shall take place on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling to Dollard Lane from North:

Travel north on Harlockstown Lane, continue on Gracedieu northbound, turn left on R129 westbound towards Ballyboughal village, turn left onto R108 southbound, then turn left onto Balheary Avenue eastbound and continue on Balheary Avenue. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Traffic travelling to Dollard Lane from South:

Travel west on Balheary Avenue, turn right onto R108 northbound towards Ballyboughal village, turn right onto R129 westbound, turn right onto Gracedieu southbound, then continue onto Harlockstown Lane southbound. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
