## ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HARBOUR ROAD JUNCTION AND SEAPOINT LANE, BALBRIGGAN, CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council have made an order to temporarily close the Harbour Road and Seapoint Lane Junction, Balbriggan, Co. Dublin for the purpose of resurfacing works on the road and the construction of a new step area. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 1st December 2025** to 18th December 2025 for 24 hours per day.

Permitted working hours shall be between 08.00 to 18.00 each day.

No works shall take place on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

No submissions were made during the consultation process.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Due to restricted clearance under the Irish Rail bridge, HGVs must use the following route:

**For HGV vehicles travelling northbound:** From Seapoint Lane, turn left onto Seapoint Road, then right onto the R127 (Lawless Terrace/Market Green westbound). Continue straight along Market Green and, at the junction with the R132, turn right and proceed north. Turn right onto Quay Street and follow the route back to Harbour Road. End of diversion.

**For HGV vehicles travelling southbound:** From Seapoint Lane (Harbour side), turn right onto Mill Street and continue westbound. At the junction with the R132, turn left and proceed south. Turn left again onto the R127 (Lawless Terrace/Market Green eastbound). Continue straight along Market Green, then turn left onto Fancourt Road and right onto Seapoint Lane. End of diversion.

All other traffic may continue to use Quay Street, subject to the height restriction at the Irish Rail bridge.

Local access only will be maintained from Seapoint Road. Residents of Seapoint Lane will still be able to access their properties via Seapoint Road.

Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
