



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DUBLIN ROAD, LUSK, CO. DUBLIN.

An application has been received from Traffic Solutions Ltd for permission to temporarily close **Dublin Road, Lusk, Co. Dublin** for the purpose of facilitating the cutting of vehicle induction loops. It is proposed that the roads will be **closed on the 26th of November 2025 from 10:00hrs until 16:00hrs.**

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Diversion Route for Northbound Traffic:

Northbound traffic on Dublin Road R127 should continue to Rathmore Road and turn south onto Station Road.

Diversion Route for Eastbound Traffic:

Eastbound traffic on Dublin Road should continue onto Rathmore Road and turn South onto Station Road.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
