ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75 PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CLONARD ROAD, CLOGHEDER, CO. DUBLIN.

An application has been received from Glenveagh Homes Limited for permission to temporarily close **Clonard Road**, **Clogheder**, **Co. Dublin** to facilitate the installation of drainage and ESB ducting to accommodate the new development in Folkstown, Taylor Hill. It is proposed that the roads will be closed from the **12th of January 2026 to the 6th of February 2026 for 24 hours**.

Permitted working hours shall be between 08:00hrs and 19:00hrs.

No works shall take place on weekends and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling towards Clonard Road from the Naul Road (R122): Traffic travelling from the Naul Road will be diverted at the junction with Clonard Road. Traffic will continue along the Naul Road and follow diversion signage directing vehicles towards Flemington Lane. Advance signage will inform drivers of the upcoming road closure on Clonard Road.

Traffic travelling towards Clonard Road from Flemington Lane / Flemington Road: Traffic travelling from Flemington Lane will be directed to continue towards the Naul Road (R122). At the junction, traffic will follow the diversion route along the Naul Road to access alternative routes. Advance signage will notify drivers of the closure ahead on Clonard Road.

Traffic approaching the closure from the west side of Clonard Road: Traffic travelling eastbound along Clonard Road will be diverted before reaching the works area. Vehicles will be directed to turn back toward the Naul Road (R122) and follow diversion signage to re-route via Flemington Lane. Advance signage will inform drivers of the road closure and diversion.

Local access to residents and businesses within the closure zone will be maintained at all times. TM operatives will be present at closure points to manage access, provide direction, and assist pedestrians as indicated on the TM layout.
