



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET HOWTH  
& TUCKETTS LANE HOWTH

An application has been made by Fingal County Council Operation’s Department for the temporary closure of **Main Street, Howth, Co Dublin at its junction with Tuckett’s Lane**. It is proposed also to close Tuckett’s Lane between Main Street, Howth as far as the junction with St. Nessan’s and St. Lawrence Terrace.

The purpose of this closure is to facilitate surface water drainage works across Main Street Howth.

The period of the proposed temporary closure will be from **9.00am Monday 9th of March 2026 to 17.00 pm Friday 20th of March 2026**.

The alternative routes for traffic travelling the proposed closure are as follows:

| From Main Street Howth  | Junction of Tuckett’s Lane with St. Lawrence and St. Nessan’s Terrace | From Main Street Howth, use St. Lawrence Road and St. Lawrence Terrace for Tuckett’s Lane |

Local access will be provided for residents and pedestrians along length of closure.
