



**ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75**  
**PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ST. NESSANS TERRACE**  
**- HOWTH**

An application has been made by Fingal County Council Operations Department for the temporary closure of **St. Saint Nessans Terrace Howth, Co Dublin**. It is proposed to close St. Saint Nessans Terrace with its junction at Tuckett’s Lane and St. Lawrences Terrace.

The purpose of this closure is to facilitate surface water drainage works across the junction.  
The period of the proposed temporary closure will be from **9:00 am Monday 19th of January 2026 to 17:00 pm Friday 23rd of January 2026**.

The alternative routes for traffic travelling the proposed closure are as follows:

Direction of Travel	Destination	Alternative Routes
From junction of St. Nessans Terrace/Tuckett’s Lane	St. Nessans Terrace & Close	St. Lawrence Terrace and St. Lawrence Road, Main Street, and Seaview Terrace
From St. Nessans Terrace	Junction of St. Nessans Terrace/Tuckett’s Lane	Use Seaview Terrace, Main Street Howth, St. Lawrence Road and St. Lawrence Terrace

Local access will be provided for residents and pedestrians along length of closure.
