



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF OLD BARRACK ROAD, RUSH, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from ESB Networks for permission to temporarily close Old Barrack Road, Rush Co. Dublin for the purpose of ESB duct installation. It is proposed that the road will be closed from **9th February 2026 to 13th February 2026 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **08:00hrs and 19:00hrs Monday to Friday.**

The old Barrack Rd will be completely closed from the junction at Bawn Road up to the junction at Lower Main Street.

Motorists travelling north from Bawn Road:

Continue to travel along Bawn Road until the intersection with Lower Main Street, turn right onto Lower Main Street and continue until the diversion route ends.

Motorists travelling south from Lower Main Street:

Continue on Lower Main St to the intersection with Bawn Road, turn left onto Bawn Road and continue on Bawn Road until the diversion route ends.

Diversion signage will be in place for the duration of the closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
