



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SOUTH SHORE ROAD, RUSH, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from ESB Networks for permission to temporarily close South Shore Road, Rush Co. Dublin for the purpose of ESB duct installation. It is proposed that the road will be **closed from 16th February 2026 to 20th February 2026 for 24 hours per day.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **08:00hrs and 19:30hrs Monday to Friday.**

No works shall take place on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

The South Shore Road will be closed between Daly's Lane and the junction at Golf Road.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling South-Westerly:

Turn right onto Golf Road and proceed up Corr's Lane turn left onto Channel Road and from there turn left onto Daly's Lane and then turn right back onto South Shore Road

Traffic travelling North-Easterly:

Turn left onto Daly's Lane the turn right onto Channel Road. Turn right onto Corr's Lane to Golf Road and then turn left back onto South Shore Road.

Diversion signage will be in place for the duration of the closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
