



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023– SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF L-1015 BORRANSTOWN ROAD, CO. DUBLIN.

Fingal County Council have made an order to temporarily close L-1015 Borranstown Road, Co. Dublin following an application from Fingal County Council.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate essential drainage and road repair work.

It is proposed that the period of the proposed temporary closure will be from the **3rd of March to the 24th of March 2026 for 24 hours.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **08:00hrs to 18:00hrs.**

No works shall take place on weekends and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling from Ballymadun –

Traffic travelling northbound from Ballymadun continue on L-1020 until reaching junction with L-1020 and R130 at Garristown. Turn left onto R130 until reaching junction with R130 and L-1005. Turn left onto L-1005 until reaching crossroad with L-5007 and continue straight on L-5007 until reaching junction with L-5007 and L-5008. Turn left onto L-5008. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Traffic travelling from Moneyhill –

Traffic travelling southbound from Moneyhill continue on L-5008 until reaching junction with L-5008 and L-5007. Turn right onto L-5007 until reaching crossroad with L-1005 and continue straight on L-1005 until reaching junction with L-1005 and R130 at Garristown. Turn right onto R130 until reaching junction with R130 and L-1020. Turn right onto L-1020. Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
