



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS IN DONABATE, CO. DUBLIN.

An application has been received from Donabate St Patrick's Festival Committee for permission to temporarily close roads in the **Donabate area** for the purpose of facilitating a St. Patrick's festival and parade. It is proposed that the roads will be closed from **12.30hrs to 16:30hrs on Saturday 14th of March 2026**.

The roads in question are:

- Donabate Main Street.
- New Road.
- Chapel View.
- The R126.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic travelling through Donabate (R126) from North (Portrane) to South (Dublin direction):
Traffic travelling on the R126 shall follow the signed diversion route via the outer R126 section, then turn right onto New Road, continue on New Road and re-join the R126 on the Donabate side of the closure.

Traffic travelling through Donabate (R126) from South to North (Portrane direction):
Traffic travelling on the R126 shall follow the signed diversion route by turning right onto New Road, continue on New Road to the junction with the R126, then turn left onto the R126 and continue north via the outer R126 section, re-joining the R126 on the Portrane side of the closure.

Advance signage will inform traffic of the diversion route and road closure.

Emergency access will be maintained at all times and local access will be facilitated on a rolling basis.
