



## **ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75**

### **PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF OLD BRAZIL WAY/ KILLEEK LANE - L-72650, CO. DUBLIN**

An application has been received from TLI Group for permission to temporarily close Old Brazil Way/Killeek Lane - L-7265-0, Co. Dublin to facilitate planned works for telecoms fibre installation. It is proposed that the roads will be closed from the **23rd of March 2026 to the 25th of March 2026 from 08:00hrs and 17:00hrs.**

#### **Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:**

**Traffic travelling on the R108 from North to Old Brazil Way:** Traffic travelling on the R108 travelling South will continue South and turn Right at the junction onto Killeek Lane and then onto Old Brazil Way.

**Traffic travelling on the R108 from South to Old Brazil Way:** Traffic travelling on the R108 travelling North will turn Left at the junction onto Killeek Lane and then onto Old Brazil Way.

**Traffic travelling West on Brackenstown Road to Old Brazil Way:** Traffic travelling West on the L-2030 Brackenstown Road will turn left onto the R108 and travel South and then turn right at the Junction at Killeek Lane and then onto the Old Brazil Way.

**Traffic travelling East on Killeek Lane to Old Brazil Way:** Traffic travelling East on the Killeek Lane Road will continue on the Killeek Lane Road until the junction at the R108 where they will turn Left and travel North until the Junction at Old Brazil Way and L2030 Brackenstown Road.

Advance Signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

**Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.**
