



## **ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER (R132 CONNECTIVITY PROJECT)**

Notice is hereby given that the Chief Executive of Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on her by Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004), having consulted with the Commissioner of the Garda Síochána, and in the interests of road safety has made an order entitled Road Works Speed Limit Order (No. 1) (R132 Connectivity Project) 2026 to apply a Road Works Speed Limit of 50 km/h on part of the R132, Swords, Co. Dublin to facilitate the carrying out of the R132 Connectivity Project as set out below:

**It is proposed to introduce a speed limit of 50 km/h as follows:**

### **North bound – Travelling towards Estuary**

- Travelling North along the R132 from a point 140 metres North of the Pinnockhill Roundabout to a point 450 metres North of the Estuary Roundabout.

### **South bound – Travelling towards Pinockhill**

- Travelling South along the R132 from a point 450 metres North of the Estuary Roundabout to a point 140 metres North of the Pinnockhill Roundabout.

### **Malahide Roundabout**

- Travelling West along the R106 (Malahide Road) 50 meters of Malahide Roundabout to a point 40 metres East of the Malahide Roundabout;
- Travelling East along the R106 (Swords Road) 40 meters of Malahide Roundabout to a point 50 metres West of the Malahide Roundabout;
- Travelling Northeast along the Drynam Road 50 meters from Malahide Roundabout to Malahide Roundabout;
- Travelling Southeast from Malahide Roundabout on Drynam Road to 50 meters from Malahide Roundabout.

### **Seatown Roundabout**

- Approaching from Seatown Road West to a point 50 metres of Seatown Road Roundabout;
- Approaching from Seatown Road East to a point 50 metres of Seatown Road Roundabout.

### **Estuary Roundabout**

- Approaching from R125 (west) to a point 50 metres of Estuary Roundabout;
- Approaching from Estuary Road (northeast) to a point 50 metres of Estuary Roundabout.

The Road Works Speed Limit will be in effect for the **1st March 2026 to 28th February 2027**.
