



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TOWNYARD LANE, MALAHIDE, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from GMC UTILITIES GROUP LIMITED working on behalf of UISCE EIREANN to temporarily close Townyard Lane, Malahide, Co. Dublin. The purpose of this closure is to facilitate wastewater connection works by the junction of Townyard Lane and The Green.

The period of the proposed temporary closure will be from **19:00pm Monday 13th of April 2026 to 5:00am Tuesday 14th of April 2026.**

The alternative routes for traffic travelling in the area during the proposed closure duration are as follows:

Direction of Travel	Destination	Alternative Routes
East or West along the Malahide Road (R106)	The Marina Village, Strand Road, The Green or St. James Terrace	Old Street

Local access will be provided over the period of the proposed closure.
