

Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 and Section 46 of the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009 hereby gives notice that it has prepared a scheme for the provision of traffic calming measures at the following locations:


- R122, Oldtown, Co. Dublin. - 8 No. Bus Friendly Ramp Traffic Calming Ramps.
- Palmer Road Rush, Co. Dublin. - 6 No. Round Top Traffic Calming Ramps.
- Old Road, Rush, Co. Dublin. - 9 No. Round Top Traffic Calming Ramps.
- Old Market Green, Balbriggan. - 1 No. Raised Zebra Crossing & 1 No. Raised Uncontrolled Pedestrian Crossing.
- Dublin Road, Lusk, Co. Dublin. - 1 No. Raised Zebra Crossing.
- Brackenstown Avenue, Swords, Co. Dublin. - 1 No. Raised Uncontrolled Pedestrian Crossing.
- Entrance to School Portrane Road, Donabate, Co. Dublin. - 1 No. Raised Uncontrolled Pedestrian Crossing.
- Rathbeale Road, Swords, Co. Dublin. - Gateway treatments Road Signage, Kerbing & Road Markings.
- Jugpack Lane, Swords, Co. Dublin. - 1 No. Raised Uncontrolled Pedestrian Crossing.

The scheme includes the provision of traffic calming ramps, appropriate road signage and road markings where necessary. 


**Site Location Map**
