Rinne Comhairle Contae Fhine Gall ordú le haghaidh dúnadh sealadach bóithre ar roinnt **bóithre i bhFine Gall** Dé Máirt an 17 Márta 2026 tar éis iarratas ón Roinn Imeachtaí.

Is é cuspóir an dúnta Paráidí na Féile Pádraig a éascú ar fud an chontae.

Sráidbhaile Bhaile Bhlaínséir	Ó acomhal Ascaill an Teampaill, Bhóthar an Mhuilinn, agus Shráid Mhór Bhaile Bhlaínséir, feadh Shráid Mhór Bhaile Bhlaínséir, ag casadh ag an acomhal le Bóthar Chluain Saileach, agus ag críochnú ar Bhóthar Chluain Saileach idir acomhail na Sráide Móire agus Phlásóg na Rós.
Lár Baile Bhaile Brigín	Ó Charrchlós Chaisleán Bhrí Mhór, Sráid Dhroichead Átha, ar aghaidh go Sráid Bhaile Átha Cliath, agus ag críochnú ag Eaglais Naomh Peadar agus Pól.
Sráidbhaile Mhullach Íde	Bóthar Mhullach Íde/an R106 ó acomhal Bhóthar na mBallaí Buí go hacomhal Pháirc na Mara, Bóthar an Chósta.
Lár Baile Shoard	Ó Choláiste Choilm, Bóthar Bhaile Átha Cliath, feadh na Sráide Móire, ag casadh ar dheis ag acomhal Shráid an Droichid, feadh na Sráide Thuaidh, agus ag críochnú ag Páirc Bhaile Chaisleán Shoard.

Ní bhfuarthas aon aighneachtaí le linn an phróisis comhairliúcháin.

D'fhéadfadh srianta áitiúla a bheith i bhfeidhm ón Luan an 16 Márta 2026 chun go mbeifear in ann bealaí agus ardáin féachana a ullmhú. Beidh malairtí slí i bhfeidhm ón luathmhaidin an 17 Márta 2026.

## ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

### TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF A NUMBER OF ROADS IN FINGAL TO FACILITATE SAINT PATRICK'S DAY PARADES ON TUESDAY 17TH MARCH 2026

Fingal County Council has made an order for the temporary road closure of **a number of roads in Fingal** on Tuesday 17th March 2026 following an application from the Events Department.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate Saint Patrick's Day Parades across the county.

It is proposed to temporarily close a number of roads at the locations listed below:

Location	Route
Blanchardstown Village	From the junction of Church Avenue, Mill Road, and Main Street Blanchardstown, along Blanchardstown Main Street, turning at the junction with Clonsilla Road, terminating on Clonsilla Road between Main Street and Roselawn junctions.
Balbriggan Town Centre	From Bremore Castle Car Park, Drogheda Street, through to Dublin Street, finishing at St. Peter & Pauls Church.
Malahide Village	Malahide Road/ (R106) from the junction of Yellow Walls Road to the junction of Seapark, Coast Road.
Swords Town Centre	From Coláiste Choilm, Dublin Road, along Main Street, turning right at the Bridge Street junction, along North Street and finishing at Swords Castle Town Park.

No submissions were received during the consultation process.

Local restrictions may be in place from Monday 16th March 2026 to permit route and viewing platforms set-up. Route diversions will be in place from early morning on 17th March 2026.

Locally arranged St. Patrick's Day Parades will also take place throughout Fingal. Details will be advertised separately.

**Emergency access will be maintained at all times, and local access will be facilitated on a rolling basis for all parades.**
