



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MILL STREET TO GEORGE’S HILL JUNCTION, BALBRIGGAN, CO. DUBLIN.

An application has been received from GMC Utilities on behalf of Uisce Éireann for permission to temporarily close **Mill Street to George’s Hill junction, Balbriggan, Co. Dublin** to facilitate a drinking water connection for RNLi Boathouse. It is proposed that the roads will be **closed on the 13th of April 2026** from **08:00hrs and 18:00hrs**.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

George’s Hill will be closed from the junction with Mill Street to the junction with Drogheda Street. Local access will be allowed from Mill Street.

As George’s Hill is a one-way road, alternative routes for travel are not available. Local access will be allowed from Mill Street.

Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
