



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023– SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS IN SKERRIES, CO. DUBLIN.

Fingal County Council has made an Order to temporarily close **roads in the Skerries area** for the purpose of holding a 10km Road Race. It is proposed that the roads will be **closed from 09:30am to 11:15am on Sunday 15th of March 2026.**

0 submissions were made during the consultation process.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Access from Skerries to Balbriggan:

At Millers Lane/Holmpatrick proceed southbound towards Rush using one way system and stop/go system at Skerries Rugby Club. Proceed onto R128 towards southbound towards Rush and at the crossroads R128 take right turn onto L1285. At the T junction of R127 turn right then turn left at the T-Junction onto Grange Lodge Avenue, signposted Ardgillan Castle. Turn left at the T-Junction onto Killalene Road, continuing onto Killary Grove. Take the right turn at the T-Junction continuing onto Darcystown Road through Rose Park. At the T junction turn right onto Coach Road then take the left turn onto School Lane. Take right onto Old Coach Road and at the R132 take the right turn onto the R132.

Access from Balbriggan to Skerries:

Take the R132 to Balrothery and take the left turn, signposted Ardgillan Park. Turn right onto Coach Road then take the left onto Rosepark Road then onto the Darcystown Road. Continue along Ringfort View, Darcystown Road and Killary Grove then take the left turn at the T-Junction continuing on Killary Grove onto Killalene. Take the right turn onto Grange Lodge Avenue. Take the right turn at the T- Junction at R127. Take the left turn at the T-Junction onto the L1275 then at the R132 Junction take the left turn.

Access from Rush to Skerries:

At junction R128 / Shenick Road turn left towards Millers Lane, via one way system. At crossroads turn right using stop/go system and proceed to Skerries via Golf Links Road and Millers Lane.

Access from Skerries to Rush:

At Millers Lane/Holmpatrick proceed southbound towards Rush using one way system and stop/go system at Skerries Rugby Club. Proceed onto R128 towards southbound towards Rush.

Access from Lusk to Skerries:

At Skerries Road roundabout take the 2nd exit on R127 towards Skerries then at the T junction, turn right onto L1285 direction Loughshinny, L1285 via Baldongan to crossroads Loughshinny. Then turn left at the crossroads onto R128 direction Skerries.

Access from Skerries to Lusk:

Take the R128, direction Rush to Loughshinny and at the crossroads, turn right onto L1285 via Baldongan and turn left at the T junction onto main Skerries Lusk Road (R127) direction Lusk

Advance signage will inform of diversion routes.

Emergency access will be maintained at all times, and local access will be facilitated on a rolling basis.
