



## **ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75**

### **PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TURVEY AVENUE, DONABATE, CO. DUBLIN**

An application has been received from Fingal County Council for permission to temporarily close **Turvey Avenue, Donabate, Co. Dublin** to facilitate road surfacing works. It is proposed that the roads will be closed from the **2nd of June 2026 to the 19th of June 2026 for 24 hours.**

Permitted working hours shall be between 08:00hrs and 21:00hrs Monday to Friday.

No works shall take place on Saturdays, Sundays, and Bank Holidays.

#### **Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:**

**Traffic travelling to Donabate from R132:** Traffic travelling from R132, continue on the R132 to Lissenhall Interchange, turn left onto R127 Hearse Road and on into Donabate.

**Traffic travelling from Donabate to R132:** Traffic travelling from Donabate, continue onto R127 Hearse Road to Lissenhall Interchange onto the R132.

Advance signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

#### **Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.**
