



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE

OF STRAND STREET TOWNPARKS

SKERRIES CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from GMC Utilities Ltd on behalf of Uisce Eireann for permission to temporarily close a section of Strand Street Skerries Co. Dublin for the purpose of installing a wastewater connection. It is proposed that the road will be closed from the **15th June to the 16th June 2026**.

Permitted working hours shall be between **08:00hrs and 20:00hr on both days**.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

For traffic approaching from the North: At the roundabout, take the second exit onto Thomas Hand Street, continue straight until the left turn onto Church Street; continue straight until the junction with Strand Street/ Holmpatrick R128.

For traffic approaching from the South: Turn left onto Church Street; continue straight until the right turn onto Thomas Hand Street; then continue straight until the roundabout on Strand Street.

Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
