



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF

L5166 ROAD, JORDANSTOWN, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from Triur Construction on behalf of Fingal County Council for permission to temporarily close **L5166 Road, Jordanstown, Co. Dublin** to facilitate bridge maintenance. It is proposed that the roads will be **closed from the 29th of June 2026 to the 10th of July 2026 for 24 hours.**

Permitted working hours shall be between **08:00hrs and 19:00hrs.**

No works shall take place on weekends and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic Travelling East – Traffic on the L1105 Nevitt Road continue straight through the roundabout towards the R132, then turn left onto R132. Continue along the R132 and take fourth exit at the next roundabout to head south onto R132.

Traffic Travelling West – At the roundabout take the exit onto the R132, continue on the R132 and turn right onto the L5195 Ballough-Devine's crossroad. Continue on the L5195 Ballough-Devine's crossroad and then Turn right onto the L5120 Knightstown Road. Turn right onto the L1105 Nevitt Road.

For HGV's Travelling West – Continue South onto the R132 at the roundabout. Continue along the R132 and at the roundabout at Turvey, take the fourth exit and head north on the R132.

Road signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
