



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTERSTOWN ROAD, CLONSILLA

An application has been received from Castlethorn Construction for permission to temporarily **close Porterstown Road, Clonsilla (L-3035-0)** to facilitate essential road alignment works which is part of the planning conditions.

It is proposed that the road will be closed as follows:

- **24 Hours per day from Wednesday 1st July 2026 to Tuesday 1st September 2026**

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Diversion Routes

Traffic travelling north along the Diswellstown Road towards the Porterstown Road shall be diverted along the following route:

- At Diswellstown/Porterstown Road Junction go straight ahead
- At Clonsilla roundabout take the 1st exit onto Clonsilla Rd (R121)
- Go past St Mochta's National School and take the 1st left turn off Clonsilla Road (R121)
- End Detour

Traffic travelling south along Blanchardstown Rd S (R121) towards the Porterstown Road shall be diverted along the following route:

- At Clonsilla roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Clonsilla Rd (R121)
- Go past St Mochta's National School and take the 1st left turn off Clonsilla Road (R121)
- End Detour

The road will be closed when the school is closed. Local access will be maintained.
