



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS IN SWORDS CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from Dublin Marathon DAC for permission to temporarily close various roads in the Swords area for the purpose of holding the Irish Life Fingal 10K Run. It is proposed that sections of the roads will be closed between **05:00am and 14:00pm on Sunday 12th July 2026.**

The roads in question are:

- Balheary Road - From Glen Ellan Road to Castlegrange Road - 05:00 - 13:00
- Seatown West (Castlegrange to Balheary Road) - 05:00 - 13:00
- Balheary Road (after Glen Ellan) - 09:00 - 11:30
- Harlslocktown Lane - 09:00 - 11:30
- Magillstown Road - 09:00 - 11:30
- Castlegrange Road - 05:00 - 14:00

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Detour 1 (Eastern / Northern diversion – via R132 & R129):

Traffic travelling between Swords and Blake's Cross shall follow the diversion via the R132 (both directions). Traffic travelling onwards between Blake's Cross and Ballyboughal shall follow the diversion via the R129 (Thomondstown / Baldugan Hill) (both directions).

Detour 2 (Western / Southern diversion – via R108 & R125):

Traffic travelling between Ballyboughal and Swords shall follow the diversion via the R108 (towards Roganstown) and then via the R125 (Rathbeale Road, Watery Lane, Balheary Road) back to Swords, and vice-versa in the opposite direction.

Advance warning signage and VMS will inform traffic of road closures and diversion routes.
