



## **ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75**

### **PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE R127 SKERRIES (BALCUNNIUN) TO LUSK, CO. DUBLIN**

An application has been received from Fingal County Council for permission to temporarily close **the R127 Skerries (Balcunniun) to Lusk, Co. Dublin** to facilitate the continuation and completion of road resurfacing of the R127. It is proposed that the roads will be closed from the **13th of July 2026 to the 31st of July 2026 from 7pm to 5am each night.**

**Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:**

**Traffic travelling South:** Traffic travelling in southern direction along the R127 will be informed to divert left at junction with L1285 (Finnegan's corner). Travelling for approximately 3.5km traffic will be informed to divert right at L1285/ R128 junction and continue to Rush. Traffic approaching traffic lights junction with R128/ lower main street in Rush will be informed to divert right onto main street. Traffic will continue to travel on R128 until approaching Lusk and at the Remount roundabout will be informed to take the third exit onto the R127 ring road in Lusk. Traffic will continue to travel on the R127 until approaching the Raheny roundabout and will be informed to take the second exit continuing on the R127 until approaching the Skerries road roundabout ending their diversion route.

**Traffic travelling North:** Traffic travelling in northern direction will be informed at the Skerries road roundabout to take the third exit continuing on the R127 until approach to Raheny roundabout where traffic will be informed to take the second exit continuing on the R127 until approach to the Remount roundabout where traffic will be informed to take the third exit on to the R128. Traffic will continue to travel along the R128 right through the main street in Rush until approach with the traffic light junction with the R128 and lower main street in Rush. At the traffic light junction traffic will be informed to divert left and continue on the R128 until approach with the R128/ L1285 junction. At the R128/ L1285 junction traffic will be informed to divert left on to the L1285 and continue for approximately 3.5km until approach with the R127/ L1285 junction ending their diversion route.

**Local access will be maintained at all times. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.**
