



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BAY LANE

(L 7195-0)

Chief Executive's Order OPSW/0236/2026 authorised the publication of a newspaper advert proposing the temporary road closure of Bay Lane (L-7195-0).

Following an application received from Adman Civil Projects Ltd for permission to temporarily close Bay Lane (L-7195-0) to facilitate essential ducting and Joint Bay installation.

Fingal County Council has now made an order for the temporary road closure of Bay Lane (L-7195-0).

It is proposed that the road will be closed as follows:

- **24 Hours per day from Monday 6th July 2026 to Friday 11th September 2026.**

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Diversion Routes

- **Diversion on the eastern side of Bay Lane** is southwards via L3120 Kilshane Road leading to Mitchelstown Road. Westwards along Mitchelstown Road towards Cruiserath road. Westwards along Cruiserath road towards Corduff Road. Northwards along Corduff Road until Roundabout with L3080 Ratoath and Northwest along Dual carriageway to Bay Lane western access point. There will be allowance for local access on each side of Bay Lane
- **Diversion on the western side of Bay Lane** is Southwest along dual carriageway towards Cruiserath road. Eastwards along Cruiserath road towards Mitchelstown Road. Eastwards along Mitchelstown Road towards L3120 Kilshane road. Northwards along L3120 Kilshane road to the eastern side of Bay Lane. There will be allowance for local access on each side of Bay Lane.

The road will be closed when the school is closed. Local access will be maintained.
