



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2023 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RIVERMEADE PARK, SWORDS, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received from Fingal County Council's Active Travel Department for permission to temporarily close **Rivermeade Park, Swords, Co. Dublin** for the purpose of facilitating a trial implementation of a School Street for Mary Queen of Ireland National School as part of European Mobility Week. It is proposed that the roads will be **closed from 16th September until 22nd September 2026 from 08:40 to 09:10 and 14:20 to 14:50**.

No works shall take place on weekends and Bank Holidays.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

Traffic entering Rivermeade Drive from Kilreesk Road travelling towards Rivermeade Park and Toberburr Avenue will continue straight towards Rivermeade Avenue.

Traffic exiting Rivermeade Park and Toberburr Avenue towards Kilreesk Road will travel towards Rivermeade Drive.

Local access for residents will be facilitated where possible. Emergency services access will also be made available in the event of an emergency.
