Confirmation of Minutes: Minutes were proposed by Cllr Angela Donnelly and Seconded by Cllr John Burtchaell.

Matters Arising: None

Correspondence: Items of correspondence were shared

From Paul Donnelly T D in relation to the opening of Fortlawn Cul-de sac. It was noted that this related to a Part 8 decision by Fingal County Council and that some members had concerns that the opening of the Cul-de sacs could create safety issues going forward.

And from the Irish Council of Social Housing in relation to representation on the FWLCSP which was agreed.

There was a discussion around correspondence for future meetings. Suzie to liaise with other LCSP's Co – Ordinator's and D O J to clarify best practice. It was noted that any correspondence from the public relating to anti-social / criminal behaviour should be referred to An Garda Siochana. It was also noted per standing orders correspondence should be put to the end of the meeting agenda.



- Draft Standing Orders:** Standing Orders were proposed by Cllr Eimear Carbone-Mangan and seconded by Maura Cassidy.
- Report from workshop:** The facilitated workshop report was discussed. There is a need to add communications, collaboration, racism and gender-based violence to the themes. A decision was made to conduct a literature review of the local area to form the basis of the local community safety plan.
- T. B. Y. B Campaign:** A short video promoting the 'Think Before You Buy Campaign' was played. And the communication strategy and timeline for the campaign was discussed. The Fingal West Local Community Safety Partnership agreed to support the campaign.
- AGS Crime Statistics:** Supt Curran went through some AGS statistics from 2025 for the area.
- There were 1,434 calls in relation to domestic violence.
 - Marked increase nationally in cybercrime/ fraud up by 137% national campaigns to encourage people not to disclose personal information.
 - It is vitally important that people report all crime.
 - People should ring 999 not their local garda station to report a crime.
- Scrambler Bikes:** The death of Grace Lynch by a scrambler bike was acknowledged & condemned. It was agreed that Cllr John Walsh will draft a letter from the Fingal West LCSP to go The Minister for transport calling for a national registry for scrambler bikes.
- Members Interest Items:** Foroige, D15 have launched their 'Off Limits' Campaign which is a youth led campaign to create awareness about the sharing of Explicit Images online
